Il Banchetto Bianco £12.95

Italy ABV 12.0%
Small Glass (125ml) £2.50

Light and fresh with aromatic apple and peach notes on the nose and a dry, crisp palate that has an easy-drinking style and plenty of pear, citrus and apple fruit.

Fresh, dry red with some classic Sangiovese character: crisp cherry and raspberry fruit with ripe tannins and a wave of refreshing acidity on the finish. A perfect pizza/pasta wine.

WHITE WINE SELECTION

Moonriver, Pinot Grigio £14.95

Hungary ABV 11.3%

A refreshing Pinot Grigio from an exciting new area of Hungary, produced from grapes grown on the shore of the Danube. Delicate peach and grapefruit characters combined with a ripe and zesty flavour and great minerality. More Pinot Gris than Pinot Grigio...

Poeta Sauvignon Blanc £14.95

Italy ABV 11.9%

Mouth-watering and zippy Sauvignon Blanc from the cool Veneto area bursting with citrus fruit, gooseberry and passion fruit aromas.

Saam Mountain Paarl Chenin Blanc £15.95

South Africa ABV 13.7%

Rich tropical aromas of pear, guava and ripe yellow stone fruits jump out of the glass. The abundance of flavours carries through onto the well-structured palate.

Wither Hills Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc £19.95

New Zealand ABV 13.0%

Benchmark NZ Sauvignon with intense gooseberry, ripe herbal lime notes underpinned by the classically pungent melon, guava and passion fruit aromatics.

ROSE SELECTION

Conte Vecchio Pinot Grigio Blush £15.95

Italy ABV 12.0%

The nose is fruity, slightly floral and pleasant; particularly crisp and balanced palate.

Delicato White Zinfandel £17.95

California ABV 11.5%

Fresh, dry red with some classic Sangiovese character: crisp cherry and raspberry fruit with ripe tannins and a wave of refreshing acidity on the finish. A perfect pizza/pasta wine.

RED WINE SELECTION

Argento Malbec £15.95

Argentina ABV 13.5%

This superb Malbec is deep purple in colour and offers powerful aromas of black stone fruit and floral notes. Juicy flavours of plum and blackberry, with a touch of chocolate and vanilla from oak ageing, lead into a long lingering finish with ripe velvety tannins.

Saam Mountain Paarl Shiraz £15.95

South Africa ABV 14.0%

Typical Shiraz with attractive spiciness, ripe plum, white pepper and berry flavours and a touch of oak. Very elegant wine with soft tannins and good length.

Don Duelo Gran Reserva Tinto DO Carinena £15.95

Spain ABV 12.5%

Rich and rounded with ripe fruit flavours and soft oaky tannins. It is developing that silky mature flavour we all love in old Tempranillo.

Chateau de l'Hospitalet Rouge Coteaux du Languedoc La Clape £19.95

France ABV 14.0%

A very impressive barrel-aged Grenache-Syrah-Mourvedre blend from very low-yielding vines with powerful nose of red fruits, spices, liquorice, violet and vanilla. Wonderfully ripe, aromatic and luscious palate with structured tannins and layers of fruit and complexity. Elegant and racy, Chateau l'Hospitalet can be appreciated now or kept many years in the cellar.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINE SELECTION

Torre de Gall Brut Reserva £14.30

Catalunya, Spain ABV 11.5%

Clean, crisp fizz with apple and citrus notes on the palate. Aged for more than 12 months on its lees.

Champagne De Nauroy a Reims Brut Reserve £24.50

France ABV 12%

Plenty of fruit & a very forward style. A fresh, lemony palate with a nose of brioche. Perfect as an aperitif with its fine mousse & delicate palate.

Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Brut - £40.00

ABV 12%

The strength of this golden-yellow wine is immediately pleasing to the nose while its complexity explodes on the palate. The initial notes of fruit are followed by more discreet aromas of brioche and vanilla when the wine is allowed to age in the bottle.
